CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS


- P** God calls us to rely on Him for all we need to support this body and life, all that we call “daily bread.” And He offers it “without money and without price” (Isaiah 55:1).
- C** **We confess that we have relied more on our own logic and planning, and have not totally taken God at His Word.**
- P** Our heavenly Father offers more than physical food: He freely extends to us the eternal covenant He made with Abraham (Romans 9:8) and with David (Isaiah 55:5). It was signed and sealed in Jesus, the Son of David. We have been united to God’s people of all time in His kingdom.
- C** **We confess that too often we have counted on our own good deeds and religious knowledge to insure our getting to the royal heavenly banquet hall.**
- P** Our Lord would have us extend the kingdom as we meet the needs of the people around us, as He told His disciples to feed the thousands (Matthew 14:16) with the bread and fish He would multiply.
- C** **We confess that we have been content to find peace in our own salvation and have not translated our faith into loving action, using God’s gifts for the good of others and the spread of the Gospel.**
- P** Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! His steadfast love endures forever (Ps. 136:1). Our Lord’s once-for-all sacrifice on the cross and His glorious resurrection not only opened heaven to us; they have covered our sins of weak faith, pride, and inactivity. As a called and ordained servant of Christ and by His authority, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the T Son and of the Holy Spirit. Come and be nourished on the bounty of God’s Word and Sacraments.
