

OPENING SENTENCES

Mark 14:38; 1 Peter 5:8; 1 Corinthians 10:12-13

- P Jesus said, "Watch and pray that you may not enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak."

PROCLAMATION OF CHRIST


- As often as we eat this bread and drink this cup, we proclaim the Lord's death until He comes.






POST-COMMUNION THANKSGIVING
