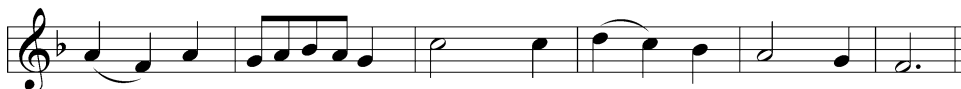

PRAYER OF THE CHURCH
